**WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:** Extends deadline by five days for filing nomination petition or declaration of nomination, and for filing voters' pamphlet information, in the event of an untimely vacancy in partisan elective office, if vacancy occurs after the 80<sup>th</sup> day and before the 70<sup>th</sup> day before the date of the primary election.

## **ISSUES DISCUSSED:**

- Tight deadlines for voters' pamphlet submissions
- Potential conflict with HB 2249 (2011)
- 2010 State Treasurer candidate experiences

**EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT:** No amendment.

**BACKGROUND:** Oregon State Treasurer Ben Westlund died Sunday March 7, 2010. Because the primary election was scheduled for 72 days later, Tuesday May 18, 2010, the filing deadline, "70 days prior to the primary," was two days after Treasurer Westlund's death. Had the provisions of HB 2433 been in effect, prospective candidates would have had an extra five days to file.
