**WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:** Increases damages for taking certain game mammals from \$800 to \$1000. Deems damages stated in ORS 496.705 as the value of the wildlife for purposes of certain crimes.

**BACKGROUND:** The increase in damages in House Bill 2439 permits the taking of non-trophy animals to be prosecuted at a higher level than is currently possible.
