WHAT THE MEASURE DOES: Exempts from taxation any property owned, acquired, or possessed by Indian tribe in Oregon or by an entity owned by an Indian tribe in Oregon if the property is used for government services. Applies to tax years beginning on or after July 1, 2011.

EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT: No amendment.

BACKGROUND: Already exempt from taxation is property of the state and public or corporate property used or intended for corporate purposes of the counties, cities, towns, school districts, irrigation districts, drainage districts, ports, water districts, housing authorities and all other public or municipal corporations in the state.
