WHAT THE MEASURE DOES: Allows agent to sign assignment of judgment on behalf of judgment creditor.

## **ISSUES DISCUSSED:**

Provisions of measure

**EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT:** No amendment.

**BACKGROUND:** Currently only a creditor or a creditor's attorney may sign an assignment of judgment. Agents may complete all the procedural aspects of obtaining the judgment, but cannot then assign it for collection. House Bill 2077 would permit assignment by the agent.
