WHAT THE MEASURE DOES: Increases bad check fee from \$25 to \$35. Declares emergency, effective on passage.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

- Retailers discouraged from accepting checks due to losses
- Flat fee versus "reasonable" capped fee
- Litigation regarding "reasonable"
- Disproportionate impact of flat fee on poor
- Snowball effect of accumulated charges

EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT: No amendment.

BACKGROUND: The cap of \$25.00 for dishonored checks has been in place for twenty-two years. House Bill 2678 increases this amount to a flat fee of \$35.00.
