WHAT THE MEASURE DOES: Repeals statutes pertaining to defunct Astor experiment station (Station).

EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT: No amendment.

BACKGROUND: In 1969 the Legislative Assembly established the Station. The Station was created in order to investigate and demonstrate the conditions under which useful plants, grains and fruits may be grown on submersible lands, reclaimed swamp lands and logged-off lands and to determine the kinds of plants, grains and fruits best adapted for growth on such lands. House Bill 2755 repeals the statutes relating to the Station.
