**WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:** Increases penalty for crime of criminal mistreatment in the first degree to a Class B felony if the victim is 65 years of age or older.

## **ISSUES DISCUSSED:**

• A specific example of elder abuse

**EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT:** No amendment.

**BACKGROUND:** A Class B felony is punishable by a maximum of 10 years' imprisonment, \$250,000 fine, or both. The current classification, Class C, is punishable by a maximum of five years' imprisonment, \$125,000 fine, or both. The original criminal penalty was enacted in 1973.
