## **REVENUE:** No revenue impact

**WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:** Prohibits the Department of Land Conservation and Development from promulgating administrative rules relating to requiring a transportation financing program for urban growth boundaries containing less than 10,000 people.

## **ISSUES DISCUSSED:**

- Increases exemption for communities
- Funding highway projects is unmanageable for small communities
- Traffic and congestion growth will often be mitigated within the community

## EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT: No amendment.

**BACKGROUND:** The Department of Land Conservation and Development may currently exempt communities under 10,000 people from land use planning goals, guidelines, and administrative rules that relate to transportation planning.
