**WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:** Exempts certain individuals providing volunteer golf course marshal services from minimum wage standards.

## **ISSUES DISCUSSED:**

- Compensation for volunteer golf course marshals
- Golf course marshal duties
- Impact of the golf industry on Oregon's economy

**EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT:** Removes provisions regarding mandatory workers' compensation coverage.

**BACKGROUND:** Oregon statute requires that the majority of workers are subject to minimum wage standards, mandatory workers' compensation coverage, and unemployment compensation taxation requirements, unless explicitly exempted. House Bill 3030-A exempts golf course marshals whose services are limited to monitoring start times/speed of play and informing golfers of golf course etiquette, performing such for no more than 30 hours per week, and receiving no wage other than golf passes, from being subject to minimum wage standards.
