WHAT THE MEASURE DOES: Exempts from minimum wage standards certain individuals providing volunteer golf course marshal services.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

• Persons to whom the measure applies

EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT: No amendment.

BACKGROUND: Current law requires that the majority of workers not explicitly exempted are subject to minimum wage standards, mandatory workers' compensation coverage, and unemployment compensation taxation requirements. House Bill 3030-A exempts golf course marshals whose services are limited to monitoring start times/speed of play and informing golfers of golf course etiquette, performing such for no more than 30 hours per week, and receiving no wage other than golf passes, from being subject to minimum wage standards.
