## **ISSUES DISCUSSED:**

The Columbia River Crossing is an important part of the Oregon transportation system and needs further review •

## EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT: No amendment.

BACKGROUND: Requires ODOT to report to the Legislative Assembly before February 1, 2013, on the importance of bridges to Oregon's interstate transportation system. There are many options to the river crossing and House Bill 3158 directs ODOT to study other options for improving infrastructure in the I-5 corridor.
