WHAT THE MEASURE DOES: Allows a household member of an officer killed in the line of duty to continue to utilize confidential addresses.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT: Changes references to “household member” for consistency

BACKGROUND: House Bill 3273-A allows the immediate family to elect to continue to use confidential address and phone records from the Driver and Motor Vehicle Services Division for up to four years.
