WHAT THE MEASURE DOES: Requires state institutions of higher learning to allow military recruitment on campus on an equal footing with other employment recruitment.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

- Message to veterans
- Oregon University System schools currently in compliance
- Military career paths for college students

EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT: Deletes provisions requiring private institutions of higher learning that accept state educational assistance to allow military recruitment on campus.

BACKGROUND: House Bill 3336-A requires all state community colleges, universities and the Oregon Health and Science University to allow members and agents of the Armed Forces of the United States to recruit on campus under rules and standards established for other employment recruitment activities. Representatives of the Oregon University System confirm that this measure is consistent with current practices on state college campuses.
