WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

Implements Ballot Measure 69, which was passed by the voters in May 2010. Changes statute and chapter law to align with changes made to Article XI-F(1) and Article XI-G of the Oregon Constitution governing general obligation bonding for post-secondary education.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

- Need for early passage of the bill

EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT: No amendment.

BACKGROUND: Ballot Measure 69 was passed by the voters during the May 2010 Primary Election with 72% approval.
