WHAT THE MEASURE DOES: Increases the amount Department of Education may expend from the State School Fund to provide administration of and support for development of talented and gifted education programs.

ISSUES DISCUSSED: No discussion.

EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT: No amendment.

BACKGROUND: Current statute specifies that the Department of Education may expend up to \$350,000 per biennium for development and support of programs for academically talented and intellectually gifted students. House Bill 3463 increases this expenditure limit to \$400,000 per biennium.
