WHAT THE MEASURE DOES: Modifies crime of theft in first degree to include theft of agricultural property valued at \$100 or more from special assessment land when person commits criminal trespass in the second degree.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

- Industry vulnerable to theft because products not stored in warehouse
- Process for determining value of stolen product

EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT: No amendment.

BACKGROUND: A person commits criminal trespass in the second degree if the person unlawfully enters property or a vehicle or unlawfully remains in a vehicle or on the premises (ORS 164.245). Criminal trespass in the second degree is a Class C misdemeanor. Theft in the first degree is a Class C felony.
