**WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:** Extends the sunset for income and corporate excise tax credits for energy facilities until January 1, 2022.

**ISSUES DISCUSSED:**

- Provisions of the measure

**EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT:** No amendment.

**BACKGROUND:** House Bill 3680 (2010) extended the renewable manufacturing projects under the Business Energy Tax Credit (BETC) program until January 1, 2014, and all other portions of the program to January 1, 2012, for pre-certification. House Bill 3582 extends the sunset provisions to January 1, 2022.
