WHAT THE MEASURE DOES: Allows the International Port of Coos Bay to own and operate a rail line connecting the Danebo station in Lane County to the Coquille station in Coos County

MEASURE: HB 3596

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

- Port authorities need express authorization
- Ports often fall under multiple jurisdictions

EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT: No amendment.

BACKGROUND: House Bill 3596 authorizes the Port of Coos Bay to annex, at the request of the owning entity, the rail line rights-of-way or industrial lands contiguous to rights-of-way. Any annexation overlapping with another port does not infringe on the territory of the other port.
