**WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:** Declares February 6, 2011, the 100<sup>th</sup> anniversary of his birth, Ronald Reagan Day in Oregon.

**ISSUES DISCUSSED:**

- Contributions of the 40<sup>th</sup> President of the United States
- Personal experiences with President Reagan's election campaigns and Presidential Library

**EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT:** No amendment.

**BACKGROUND:** In his 1984 re-election, Ronald Reagan won Oregon's seven electoral vote with 685,700 votes (55.9 percent) to Walter Mondale's 536,479 votes (43.7 percent), winning every Oregon county but four.
