EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT: No amendment.

BACKGROUND: Oregon State Police Sergeant Richard J. Schuening died from explosion injuries he received while performing his duties as a Hazardous Devices Technician with the Oregon State Police on October 2, 1997.

House Bill 3039-A directs the Department of Transportation to erect and maintain a roadside memorial sign for police officers killed in line of duty if the Legislative Assembly adopts a concurrent resolution that recognizes the police officer.
