WHAT THE MEASURE DOES: Honors Oregon State Police Senior Trooper Maria Mignano (1962-2001)

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

Trooper Mignano's law enforcement career and service to her community ٠

EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT:

BACKGROUND: Oregon State Police Senior Trooper Maria Mignano and Officer Jason Hoerauf of the Albany Police Department were struck and killed by a vehicle while assisting a family whose van was disabled on I-5 south of Salem. As a young adult in California, Trooper Mignano attended Los Angeles Harbor College, where she studied to be an emergency medical technician before moving to the Willamette Valley.

In June 1993, Senior Trooper Mignano entered the Oregon State Police Recruit School and after graduation, was assigned to the Salem office, where she served for eight years. Senior Trooper Mignano also served on the Mobile Response Team, earned an Officer of the Year Award, and was certified as a Drug Recognition Expert.
