WHAT THE MEASURE DOES: Honors Albany Police Officer Jason Hoerauf (1972-2001).

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

- Highlights of Officer Hoerauf's police career
- Provisions of House Bill 3039-A
- Locations of proposed memorial signs

EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT: No amendment.

BACKGROUND: Albany Police Officer Jason Hoerauf and Trooper Maria Mignano, of the Oregon State Police, were struck and killed by a vehicle while assisting a family with a disabled van on I-5 south of Salem.

House Bill 3039-A directs the Department of Transportation to erect and maintain a roadside memorial sign for police officers killed in line of duty if the Legislative Assembly adopts a concurrent resolution that recognizes the police officer.
