WHAT THE MEASURE DOES: Honors Albany Police Officer Jason Hoerauf (1972-2001).

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

- Law enforcement career of Officer Hoerauf
- Honoring of police officers killed in line of duty

EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT: No amendment.

BACKGROUND: Albany Police Officer Jason Hoerauf and Trooper Maria Mignano of the Oregon State Police, were struck and killed by a vehicle while assisting a family with a disabled van on I-5 south of Salem.

Officer Hoerauf began his law enforcement as a reserve officer for the City of Philomath Police Department, the Benton County Sheriff's Office and the Albany Police Department. He entered the Albany Police Department recruit school in late 1999 and, after graduating, he was assigned to the Albany Police Department. Officer Hoerauf was a hardworking, dedicated law enforcement officer who loved serving with the Albany Police Department.
