**WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:** Honors Oregon State Police Trooper Scott A. Lyons (1974-1997).

**ISSUES DISCUSSED:**

**EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT:** No amendment.

**BACKGROUND:** Oregon State Police Trooper Scott A. Lyons was killed in a traffic collision along with Oregon State Police Sergeant James D. Rector while on routine patrol west of Crescent, Oregon on September 2, 1997.

House Bill 3039-A directs the Department of Transportation to erect and maintain a roadside memorial sign for police officers killed in line of duty if the Legislative Assembly adopts a concurrent resolution that recognizes the police officer.
