BACKGROUND: Oregon State Police Trooper Scott A. Lyons was killed in a traffic collision, along with Oregon State Police Sergeant James D. Rector, while on routine patrol west of Crescent, Oregon on September 2, 1997.

A native Oregonian, Trooper Lyons was a graduate Bend High School and attended Western Oregon University before entering the Oregon State Police (OSP) Recruit School in 1994. Upon graduation from OSP Recruit School, Trooper Lyons served the Gilchrist-Crescent area.
