EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT: No amendment.

BACKGROUND: Oregon State Police Senior Trooper Bill Hakim and Captain Tom Tennant of the Woodburn Police Department were killed December 12, 2008, when a bomb detonated as they examined the device.

House Bill 3039-A directs the Department of Transportation to erect and maintain a roadside memorial sign for police officers killed in line of duty if the Legislative Assembly adopts a concurrent resolution that recognizes the police officer.
