WHAT THE MEASURE DOES: Honors Oregon State Police Sergeant James D. Rector (1950-1997).

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT: No amendment.

BACKGROUND: Oregon State Police Sergeant James D. Rector was killed in a traffic collision along with Trooper Scott A. Lyons while on routine patrol west of Crescent, Oregon on September 2, 1997.

House Bill 3039-A directs the Department of Transportation to erect and maintain a roadside memorial sign for police officers killed in line of duty if the Legislative Assembly adopts a concurrent resolution that recognizes the police officer.
