**WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:** Honors Oregon State Police Sergeant James D. Rector (1950-1997).

**ISSUES DISCUSSED:**

- Provisions of resolution

**EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT:** No amendment.

**BACKGROUND:** Oregon State Police Sergeant James D. Rector was killed in a traffic collision, along with Trooper Scott A. Lyons, while on routine patrol west of Crescent, Oregon on September 2, 1997.

A native Oregonian, after graduating high school Sergeant Rector served in the United States Army and was a veteran of the Vietnam War. After graduating from Oregon State Police (OSP) Recruit School in 1973, he served the Klamath Falls and Gilchrist-Crescent area. In addition to his service with OSP, Sergeant Rector volunteered with Neighborhood Watch groups and the Drug Abuse Resistance Education (DARE) program in local schools.
