WHAT THE MEASURE DOES: Honors Oregon State Police Trooper Dan A. Nelson (1948 – 1972).

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT: No amendment.

BACKGROUND: Oregon State Police Trooper Dan A. Nelson of Salem was killed on the shoulder of Interstate 5 north of Salem on July 28, 1972, while issuing a warning to a motorist.

House Bill 3039-A directs the Department of Transportation to erect and maintain a roadside memorial sign for police officers killed in line of duty if the Legislative Assembly adopts a concurrent resolution that recognizes the police officer.
