WHAT THE MEASURE DOES: Honors Oregon State Police Superintendent Holly V. Holcomb (1917-1975).

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

- Reputation of Holly V. Holcomb as Oregon State Police Superintendent
- Provisions of House Bill 3039-A
- Locations of proposed memorial signs

EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT: No amendment.

BACKGROUND: Oregon State Police Superintendent Holly Holcomb died on November 25, 1975, having been shot in front of the Public Service Building in Salem during a confrontation with a former member of the agency.

House Bill 3039-A directs the Department of Transportation to erect and maintain a roadside memorial sign for police officers killed in line of duty if the Legislative Assembly adopts a concurrent resolution that recognizes the police officer.
