EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT: No amendment.

BACKGROUND: Phil Lang, a graduate of Lewis and Clark College, served in the U.S. Air Force, and as an Oregon State Police trooper. He served nine terms in the Oregon House of Representatives from 1960 to 1979 and was elected by his peers as Speaker of the House. He served as Chair of the Oregon Liquor Control Commission for eight years, and is retiring this month from his position as chairman of the board of the National Alcohol Beverage Control Association (NABCA), a group of 20 state and county liquor agencies headquartered in Alexandria, Virginia.

The offices of all but two of Oregon's 60 state representatives are in the Phil Lang Memorial House Wing of the Oregon Capitol, completed in 1977.
