**WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:** Urges Congress to require United States Department of Veterans Affairs to pay veterans' transportation costs in certain circumstances.

## **ISSUES DISCUSSED:**

• Transportation problems highlighted by Task Force on Veterans' Transportation

**EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT:** No amendment.

**BACKGROUND:** The 2009 Legislature passed Senate Bill 98, which created a Task Force on Veterans' Transportation (Task Force). The Task Force Report indicates that under current law, the Veterans Administration is required to pay for a veteran who is in need of immediate treatment at the nearest emergency room. Once the veteran is stable, the veteran must be transported to a Veterans Administration facility. The Task Force discovered that hospitals were not being reimbursed when they transferred veterans from their hospitals to the Veterans Administration facility. House Joint Memorial 6 urges Congress to correct this discrepancy.
