WHAT THE MEASURE DOES: Urges Congress to enact community-based health care legislation for veterans and to allow state veterans' homes to provide assisted living for veterans.

CARRIER: Sen. Monnes Anderson

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

- Options for community-based health care
- Importance of independent living with adequate support

EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT: No amendment.

BACKGROUND: The philosophy of the Veterans Health Administration is to place veterans who require long-term care in the least restrictive environment, preferably at home or in community-based systems. The United States Department of Veterans' Affairs (USDVA) generally does not pay for community-based long term care.

House Joint Memorial 15 urges Congress to allow the USDVA to pay for veterans' care in community-based systems and to allow state veterans' homes to provide assisted living for veterans.
