WHAT THE MEASURE DOES: Urges Congress to allow for unmanned aircraft testing in rural areas.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

- Spur economic growth in rural areas

- Could bring drone industry to Central Oregon

EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT: Reduces the requested time for approval to two years.
