WHAT THE MEASURE DOES: Authorizes the Oregon Business Development Department to charge and assess fees for program benefits and administrative costs incurred to certify sites that are ready for industrial or traded sector development.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

- Funding needed to keep the industrial certification program going
- Cost can be recovered upon sale of the property
- Industrial certification program adds value to property
- Need to limit the authority to impose fees to the industrial certification program

EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT: Replaces the original measure.

BACKGROUND: The Oregon Business Development Department currently has the statutory authority to charge fees and recover costs for the business finance/loan programs it administers. Senate Bill 56 A allows the Department to recover costs from land owners for administering the industrial lands site certification program.
