**WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:** Allows the Oregon Racing Commission to establish by rule the license fees for officials, track operators and other race meet participants and removes the current fee prices established in statute.

## **ISSUES DISCUSSED:**

- Fee rates in other states
- Whether fees should be set in statute on made through administrative rule
- Length of time since fees have been raised

## **EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT:** No amendment.

**BACKGROUND:** ORS 462.070 establishes license fees for officials, track operators and other race meet participants. The current cost for racing licenses is \$10.00 per year for the initial license category and \$2.00 for each additional license category. The fees were established by this statute in 1979.
