**WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:** Authorizes the Travel Information Council to issue citations for violations of health and safety rules at roadside rest areas managed by Council.

**ISSUES DISCUSSED:**

- Income from fines going to the General Fund
- Need for enforcement of existing rules at rest areas

**EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT:** No amendment.

**BACKGROUND:** House Bill 2001, enacted by the 2009 Legislative Assembly, required the Oregon Department of Transportation to enter into an intergovernmental agreement with the Travel Information Council to authorize the Council to manage, maintain, and improve certain rest areas in Oregon. The Travel Information Council currently manages nine rest areas in Oregon.
