**WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:** Extends tax credits for rural enterprise zones to June 30, 2019 with certification prior to June 30, 2018.

## **ISSUES DISCUSSED:**

- Local government use of enterprise zones to attract businesses
- Infrequent use of the tax credit
- Interest in tax credit by larger companies

**EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT:** Defined length of tax credit extension as a six year extension.

**BACKGROUND:** The rural enterprise zone tax credit is granted to corporations that make certain large investments in a rural enterprise zone facility, if approved by the Governor. The current tax credit it set to expire June 30, 2013 with certification prior to June 30, 2012.
