**WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:** Creates an offense of driving next to a commercial vehicle. Allows a commercial vehicle to utilize more than one lane in a roundabout when necessary. Requires hazard signage in multi-lane roundabouts.

## **ISSUES DISCUSSED:**

- Safety concerns
- Current moratorium on roundabouts on state highways
- Accident rates and severity

## EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT: No amendment.

**BACKGROUND:** There are approximately 51 roundabouts in Oregon, only one of which, in Astoria, is on the State Highway system. Only seven multi-lane roundabouts currently exist in Oregon.
