WHAT THE MEASURE DOES: Limits disclosure of record of civil commitment proceeding to parties while pending and on appeal. Requires appellate court to protect identity of subject of proceedings in its opinions. Conforms disclosures to comply with federal law. Authorizes Chief Justice of Oregon Supreme Court to determine effective date of sections 2 and 4. Declares emergency, effective on passage.
