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**WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:** Requires applications for driver licenses to contain information about whether or not the applicant wants to make an anatomical gift.

**ISSUES DISCUSSED:**

- Need for anatomical gifts in Oregon
- Requiring individuals to affirmatively say yes or no to becoming an anatomical donor increases participation

**EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT:** No amendment.

**BACKGROUND:** ORS 97.953 defines “anatomical gift” as a donation of all or part of a human body to take effect after the donor’s death for the purpose of transplantation, therapy, research or education. Currently, the application forms for an original driver license, permit, or identification card contain the following question with a yes/no checkbox: ‘Do you want your license/ID card to show that you are an anatomical donor?’ However, applicants are not required to make a selection in this box in order to complete the application.
