**WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:** Requires that the independent appraiser of damage to a motor vehicle in cases of a dispute between an insurer and insured to be conducted by a person who has been issued a vehicle appraiser certificate or license issued by another state or government body in lieu of a State of Oregon vehicle appraiser certificate. Requires that the independent appraiser of damage to a motor vehicle in cases of a dispute between an insurer and insurer and insure to be competent.

## **ISSUES DISCUSSED:**

- Protecting consumers in situations where they are not experts
- Importance of arms length appraisals
- Difficulty with appraising rare and unique vehicles

**EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT:** Allows the independent appraiser of damage to a motor vehicle in cases of a dispute between an insurer and insured to be issued a license issued by another state or government body in lieu of a State of Oregon vehicle appraiser certificate. Requires that the independent appraiser of damage to a motor vehicle in cases of a dispute between an insurer and insured to be competent.

**BACKGROUND:** The Oregon Driver and Motor Vehicles Division (DMV) of the Oregon Department of Transportation issues Vehicle Appraiser Certificates. In order to be issued a certificate, applicants must have two years work experience in vehicle appraising or complete the vehicle appraiser education program.
