## **REVENUE:** No revenue impact

**WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:** Requires manufacturers to affix statement on all bicycle trailers designed for human passengers that informs purchaser of conformity or nonconformity to ASTM International specification F1975-09. Allows purchaser of bicycle trailer to bring civil action against manufacturer if does not conform to standards within two years from date of purchase. Requires a court to award a prevailing plaintiff reasonable costs and attorney fees. Applies to bicycle trailers sold on or after effective date.

## **ISSUES DISCUSSED:**

- Safety issues with bicycle trailers
- Quality of foreign manufactured bike trailers
- Parties liable in lawsuits
- Parties able to obtain reasonable costs and attorney fees

## EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT: Replaces original measure.

**BACKGROUND:** Oregon statute does not address standards for trailers sold for human passengers. Senate Bill 846 A applies only to new products, not existing trailers.
