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WHAT THE MEASURE DOES: Extends, for an additional six years, the sunset for tax credit for affordable housing lenders. Takes effect on 91<sup>st</sup> day following adjournment sine die.

## EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT: No amendment.

BACKGROUND: The Legislative Assembly created the Oregon Affordable Housing Tax Credit Program (OAHTC) in 1989. The program gives the Department of Housing and Community Services the authority to certify tax credits for projects; through the use of tax credits, lending institutions are able to lower the cost of financing by as much as four percent for housing projects or community rehabilitation programs serving low-income households.
