**BACKGROUND:** Jay Minthorn was born April 22, 1936, in Pendleton to Aaron and Elsie (McKay) Minthorn and was raised and educated in Pendleton, attending Pendleton High School. He was active in tribal politics for many years as a member of the Board of Trustees for the Confederated Tribes of the Umatilla Indian Reservation, and also served as a member of the Inter-Tribal Fish Commission. During his life he worked with tribal leaders, legislators, four governors, statewide elected officials, state agency directors and others to advance the interests of his and other tribes throughout Oregon.
