WHAT THE MEASURE DOES: Honors Eugene Water & Electric Board (EWEB) for 100 years of utility service.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

EFFECT OF COMMITTEE AMENDMENT: No amendment.

BACKGROUND: Founded in 1911, EWEB is Oregon's largest customer-owned utility and provides electricity, water and steam to more than 86,000 homes, business, schools and other customers in Eugene, Oregon. Since the first meeting of the Eugene Water Board on March 11, 1911 (the utility's name was changed in 1949), EWEB's vision has been to serve its citizen-owners with reliable electricity and healthy, clean water. The citizens of Eugene elect a five member Board of Commissioners to four year terms. Senate Concurrent Resolution 13 honors EWEB for 100 years of service to the community.
