

## SENATE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 2013

- 1       On page 8 of the printed bill, delete lines 17 through 33 and insert:
- 2       “(1) The Oregon Health Licensing Agency shall:
- 3       “(a) Determine the qualifications, training, education and fitness of applicants for licenses, re-
- 4       newal of licenses and reciprocal licenses;
- 5       “(b) Adopt rules as necessary to administer ORS 690.350 to 690.430;
- 6       “(c) Issue, deny, revoke, suspend and renew licenses;
- 7       “(d) Maintain a public record of persons holding licenses;
- 8       “(e) Establish standards of practice and professional responsibility for persons licensed by the
- 9       agency to perform services in a field of practice;
- 10       “(f) Select licensing examinations;
- 11       “(g) Establish continuing education requirements for renewal of a license;
- 12       “(h) Provide for waivers of examinations as appropriate;
- 13       “(i) Appoint representatives to conduct or supervise examinations of applicants for licensure;
- 14       “(j) Inspect the facilities of persons who perform services in one or more fields of practice; and
- 15       “(k) Issue temporary licenses to qualified applicants in accordance with rules adopted by the
- 16       agency.
- 17       “(2) Before the agency adopts rules regulating body piercing of genitals or dermal implanting,
- 18       the agency shall consult with the Oregon Medical Board to ensure that the rules protect public
- 19       safety.
- 20       “(3) The agency may consult with the Oregon Medical Board before adopting rules relating to
- 21       other body art practices.”.
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
