

HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 2042

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, delete “and 803.102” and insert “, 803.102 and 803.120”.

2 On page 2, line 4, delete “disclosure statement” and insert “reading, in the manner provided by
3 the department by rule,”.

4 In line 24, after “odometer” insert “disclosures and”.

5 On page 5, after line 16, insert:

6 “**SECTION 3.** ORS 803.120 is amended to read:

7 “803.120. (1) When an odometer disclosure is required by statute or by the Department of
8 Transportation **or an odometer reading is provided voluntarily**, the disclosure **or reading** shall
9 be in a form required by the department by rule. The department may require different forms [*of*
10 *disclosure*] for different situations and may require different information to be disclosed for different
11 purposes.

12 “(2) Any form authorized by the department for use as an odometer disclosure upon transfer of
13 an interest in a vehicle **subject to the federal law requiring disclosure of odometer information**
14 shall refer to the federal law [*requiring disclosure of odometer information*] and shall state that fail-
15 ure to complete the disclosure form, or providing false information on the form, may result in a fine
16 or imprisonment.

17 “(3) Any form authorized by the department for use as an odometer disclosure upon transfer of
18 an interest in a vehicle shall provide a way for the transferor to indicate, to the best of the
19 transferor’s knowledge, which of the following is true:

20 “(a) That the odometer reading reflects the actual mileage of the vehicle;

21 “(b) That the odometer reading reflects an amount of mileage in excess of the designed me-
22 chanical odometer limit; or

23 “(c) That the odometer reading does not reflect actual mileage and should not be relied on.

24 “(4) An odometer disclosure required upon transfer of an interest in a vehicle shall be made on
25 the vehicle title unless the department provides otherwise by rule.”.
