SUMMARY

Authorizes Director of Department of Consumer and Business Services to determine languages other than English and Spanish in which certain information made available to agricultural employers for dissemination to employees shall be provided.

5 **SECTION 1.** ORS 654.770 is amended to read:

7 basic information for agriculture employers to use in informing and training employees **pursuant**

8 to ORS 654.780. The information shall include, but need not be limited to, proper personal hygiene,

9 protective safety equipment, general safety rules, proper work clothing, employee rights with respect

to this chapter and common symptoms of hazardous chemical exposure. The basic information shall
be [developed in a variety of languages including but not limited to English, Spanish, Russian, Thai,

12 Japanese, Chinese, Laotian, Vietnamese, Korean and Cambodian] made available in English,

13 Spanish and any other language determined necessary by the Director of the Department of

Consumer and Business Services after consideration of any input received from
 stakeholders.
