

HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 2138

- 1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, after “801.208,” insert “807.031.”
- 2 In line 8, delete “or actual gross combination weight”.
- 3 In line 9, delete “whichever is greater.”
- 4 In line 10, delete “or actual gross vehicle weight” and delete “, whichever”.
- 5 In line 11, delete “is greater”.
- 6 In line 12, delete “or actual gross” and delete the second “weight”.
- 7 In line 13, delete “, whichever is greater”.
- 8 On page 2, line 7, after “vehicle” insert “by such a date as required by rule by the
- 9 department”.
- 10 On page 7, after line 36, insert:
- 11 “**SECTION 6.** ORS 807.031 is amended to read:
- 12 “807.031. This section describes the type of driving privileges granted by the various licenses
- 13 issued by this state. Licenses are established by class with the highest class being Class A com-
- 14 mercial. Each class of license grants driving privileges for that class and for all lower classes. A
- 15 license does not grant driving privileges for which an endorsement is required. The following li-
- 16 censes grant the driving privileges described:
- 17 “(1) A Class A commercial driver license authorizes a person to operate any vehicle or combi-
- 18 nation of vehicles except that the person may not operate any vehicle for which an endorsement is
- 19 required unless the person obtains the endorsement.
- 20 “(2) A Class B commercial driver license authorizes a person to operate any single vehicle and
- 21 to tow a vehicle that is not in excess of 10,000 pounds gross vehicle weight rating [*or actual gross*
- 22 *weight*]. The person may not operate any vehicle for which an endorsement is required unless the
- 23 person obtains the endorsement.
- 24 “(3) A Class C commercial driver license authorizes a person to operate:
- 25 “(a) Any vehicle that is designed to transport 16 or more persons, including the driver, if the
- 26 gross vehicle weight rating [*or actual gross weight*] of the vehicle is less than 26,001 pounds and the
- 27 person has the proper endorsement to operate a vehicle described in this paragraph;
- 28 “(b) Any vehicle that is used in the transportation of hazardous materials if the gross vehicle
- 29 weight rating [*or actual gross weight*] of the vehicle is less than 26,001 pounds and the person has
- 30 the proper endorsement; and
- 31 “(c) Any vehicle that may be operated by the holder of a Class C license.
- 32 “(4) A Class C driver license authorizes a person to operate any vehicle for which a commercial
- 33 driver license is not required except that the person may not operate any vehicle for which an
- 34 endorsement is required unless the person obtains the endorsement.
- 35 “(5) A restricted Class C license authorizes a person to operate a moped or to operate under

1 one of the permits described in ORS 807.200 as constituting a restricted Class C license. The person
2 may not operate any vehicle for which an endorsement is required or be granted any endorsements
3 for the license.”
